AMBS Early Childhood Program



Qualified educators who have experience in providing the best in a quality Catholic education for children in their early childhood years staff the Early Childhood program at AMBS. Generally, each segment has one teacher and one or two aides. The Early Childhood Program at AMBS consists of:

- ∅ “the Prep”... toddlers & twos... a full readiness program designed to:
 - stimulate imagination, self-expression and learning while nourishing social interaction and self-esteem
 - provide valuable “parent & me” time and interaction with other parents and toddlers
 - see separate sheet for specifics and registration information
- ∅ “Little Blessings Pre-School” ...three and four year old children...a program designed to:
 - provide age/ability appropriate readiness activities, stimulating advancement in developmental skills
 - create opportunities for nourishing social interaction and self-esteem
 - prepare children for positive learning experiences as they advance in school
 - stimulate growth in self-expression and a desire to learn
- ∅ “Transitions” ... children four &/or five years of age who have attended a minimum of two years of pre school and who do not meet the age and/or readiness/developmental requirements for Kindergarten ... a chance to provide the ‘gift’ of an extra year of age/ability appropriate developmental skills for your child/ren.
- ∅ “Kindergarten” ...a program for five-year-old children who meet the age and developmental requirements for Kindergarten ... instructional grouping will allow the child/ren to move forward at an appropriate pace for their individual development; fluid instructional groups will allow the teachers and aides to work on specific skill development as each child evidences readiness. Our basic Kindergarten program will provide the overall experience with “challenge/plus” programs added as defined by individual need.
